

RESOLUTION OF ADDISON TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
LAND USE MASTER PLAN
FIVE YEAR REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Addison Township Planning Commission (ATPC) has adopted the Addison Township Land Use Master Plan (Plan) in July 2002, and

WHEREAS, the Plan was reviewed in 2007 and reaffirmed by the ATPC as reflective of current land use goals, objectives and policies along with projected land use, socio-economic conditions and housing and transportation projections , and

WHEREAS, the ATPC has been apprised of the results of the same review as undertaken in 2007 at the August 9, 2011 PC meeting, including the following results from the 2010 US Decennial Census:

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Addison Township Planning Commission does maintain and affirm the current Addison Township Land Use Master Plan, without amendment, as the official policy document of the Addison Township Planning Commission in conformance with the Michigan planning enabling act.
