



Points of Interest Along the Trails at Watershed Preserve Park

Sunday, September 24, 2017

The Public is invited to join the Addison Township Park and Recreation Committee on **September 24th at 10 a.m.** to walk the Watershed Preserve Park. We will meet at the East Park Entrance parking lot, 5757 Rochester Road. This will be our third visit.

We intend to walk all the park designated trails and temporarily mark 12 to 20 special areas. They could be: native or unique plants, shrubs and trees, animal habitats, unique topography or natural areas.

At each interesting site we will place a temporary wood stake and number the interesting feature using a marking pen. We will then mark with colored survey tape and take a photo to identify the spot and place on our preliminary list. This process will take more than one or two visits as special features will appear as the seasons change. Finally, the Committee will review each area and approve our final selection. A permanent marker will be made for the site and each will be identified, A-Z and listed on our park maps and entrance trail sign.

Please join us in this selection process. Your input is welcome.
